



Requirements of the Girl Scout Patch Program:

Daisies and Brownies must complete six activities including the one starred.

Juniors must complete eight activities including the one starred. Cadettes, Seniors, and Ambassadors must complete nine activities including the one starred.

- *1. Visit the Mount Airy Museum of Regional History.
2. Learn to play checkers.
3. Receive a tree seedling to plant (in season).
4. Visit the Siamese Twins, Change and Eng's grave at the White Plains Baptist Church (Museum can provide directions upon your visit.)
5. With a friend, pretend you two are the Siamese twin brothers Chang and Eng. What if one of you wanted to watch T.V. and the other wanted to play outside? Or what if one of you was sick and in bed while the other was well? Come up with ways to solve your problems and share them with you troop.
6. Visit the Granite Quarry.
7. Plant a small 'crop' such as beans, corn, etc.
8. Attend a Special Event at the Mount Airy Museum of Regional History.
9. Make a small Indian clay pot.
10. Take a walk through the Old Town Cemetery and find the oldest grave.
11. Visit the William Alfred Moore House on Moore Avenue (Please call the Moore house for more information or to make arrangements 789-7988)
12. Take a walking tour of the historical buildings in downtown Mount Airy and through Virginia Street.
13. Visit the Herb Garden at the back of the Museum.
14. Purchase the Cross Stitch Kit from the Museum Gift Shop and complete it. (Recommended for Juniors and up only.)
